



Transport Links in Abergavenny

When considering moving into an area, one of the most important things to research is how moving to a particular town could affect your daily commute to and from work. Let's look at a brief insight into the public transport links of Abergavenny.

Rail

Abergavenny train station is situated on the Welsh Marches line connecting historically connecting commuters between Hereford and Newport. The Station provides residents of Abergavenny with a desirable forty-minute commute to Cardiff Central station. Putting it well below the UK average commute time of sixty-three minutes via rail according to the Department for Transport.

Buses

Abergavenny bus station is a short ten-minute walk from the train station. This gives you access Cardiff, Merthyr Tydfil and every other town you can think of in the surrounding area. The X43 service runs hourly connecting Abergavenny and Brecon and is the only method of public transport connecting residents to the Bannau Brycheiniog National Park. Renowned for its breathtaking walks and Dark Sky status.
